

## **SpEd 524I Playgroup Practicum Individual Supervision Meeting Guidelines for Supervisors**

During the individual supervision meeting with playgroup practicum students the supervisor will facilitate the meetings. The meeting will be composed of three sections: the first section will give students feedback on their performance in the previous playgroup. During this time help the students reflect on positive attributes of their participation in the playgroup. In addition, assist them in identifying areas of weaknesses. In order to achieve a higher level of participation from students, show selected video clips of students that reflect their strengths and areas of concerns. These clips can be used as a foundation for this discussion.

The second part of the meeting the students will inform you of their role in the next playgroup session. This will include information regarding what they would like you to observe. Before they come to the meeting, they should have the individual supervision form completed to help guide them of their desired observations. Students should select at least two-three triadic strategies to implement during the playgroup. This will include the portion of the playgroup that they will use the strategies, and examples of the specific statements that they will use to utilize the strategies. Based on that, you can provide students with feedback during the next individual meeting.

In the last section, you can conclude the meeting by giving the student the opportunity to discuss and share any issues about playgroup (e.g., planning, teaming, supplemented resources, personal and etc.)

Below are supervision questions that can assist you in facilitating the meeting.

### **Supervision Questions for Playgroup Practicum**

- 1) What things worked well for you?
- 2) What would you do differently or what might you change?

*Supervisor shows videoclips. After each one:*

- 3) What strategies did you use? Are there other strategies you could have used?
- 4) How did your group work as a team?
- 5) What is your role during the next session?

*Student should have their triadic strategy supervision form completed:*

- 6) What strategy/ies do you want to focus on using during the next session?
